## Montgomery County Student Environmental Activists to Present Report About State of Recycling in Montgomery County Public Schools

Provisions for waste reduction and recycling nonexistent in many area schools

ROCKVILLE, MD --- On Monday, August 27, 2001, outside the Montgomery County Public Schools' (MCPS) Carver Education Services Center, the Montgomery County Student Environmental Activists (MCSEA) will present its new report entitled A CLEAR PAPER TRAIL: The Failure of Montgomery County Public Schools' Waste Reduction and Environmental Education Programs to County Council President Blair Ewing.

The report, which reveals the sorry state of environmental education in MCPS, focuses on the lack of significant recycling and waste reduction programs within the school system. It is hoped that this report will persuade the school administration to fully implement environmental education and waste reduction programs.
